

Selecting a Country for your Compaq 56K V.90 HSF Mini PCI Modem

To ensure that your modem is configured properly and complies with local regulations, you must set the modem to the country where you are located.

If the modem is set for a country other than the one in which you are located, your modem could be configured incorrectly and not work properly. In addition, the incorrect setting could violate the telecommunication regulations/laws of your country.

Select the country in which you are located.

To change the assigned country for your modem:

- 1. Click **Start** at the bottom left of your desktop.
- 2. Select Settings.
- 3. Then click Control Panel.
- 4. Double-click the **System** icon.
- 5. From the System Properties screen, click the Device Manager tab.
- 6. Double-click Modem.
- 7. Double-click Compaq 56K V.90 HSF Mini PCI Modem.
- 8. From the **Modem Properties** screen, click the **Country Select** tab.
- 9. In the **Select a Country** box, find and highlight the appropriate country.
- 10. Click Apply.
- 11. Click **OK** to close Modem Properties.
- 12. Click **OK** to close System Properties.
