

Note for Microsoft® Windows® XP Home and Pro Users

During the setup process for a dial-up Internet account, a small .ins file is passed to your computer. This file contains all of your dial-up settings. If you're running Windows XP with Service Pack 2 (SP2), your computer may read the file as a potential hazard and display a series of Security Warning dialog boxes.

The first Security Warning dialog box will ask you whether you'd like to Open, Save, or Cancel. We recommend selecting the **Open** option. The next security warning offers Run and Don't Run options. Choose **Run**. This will automatically update your computer with your dial-up settings.
