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How do I	Steps to perform
<ol> <li>Set the device administrator password</li> </ol>	<ul> <li>a. Open the embedded Web server (EWS).</li> <li>b. Select the Settings tab, and then select General Security from the menu on the left side of the screen.</li> <li>c. In the Set Password area, type the new password in the boxes labeled New Password and Verify Password. If you have already set up a password, type the old password in the Old Password box.</li> <li>d. Click Apply.</li> </ul>
2 Lock the administrator tools section of the startup menu	<ul> <li>a. Press the on/off button on the device control panel to turn the device off, and then press it again to turn the device on.</li> <li>b. While the device is initializing, watch the controlpanel display. When the white HP logo appears on the black background, press the Stop button.</li> <li>c. Press 8 to move the highlight to Administrator Tools. Press 5 to select it.</li> <li>d. Press 8 to move the highlight to Change Administrator Password. Press 5 to select it.</li> <li>e. A prompt to enter a new password appears. Use the numeric keypad to type the password. A second prompt appears so you can confirm the password. Type the password.</li> <li>f. Press Start to save the password.</li> </ul>
3 Access the administrator tools section of the startup menu	<ul> <li>a. After opening the startup menu, press 8 to move the highlight to Sign In. Press 5 to select it.</li> <li>b. A prompt to enter the password appears. Use the numeric keypad to type the password.</li> <li>c. Press Start to enter the password. The Administrator Tools option should now be available.</li> <li>d. Press 8 to move the highlight to Administrator Tools. Press 5 to select it.</li> </ul>



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4 Disable printing through a direct connection	<ul> <li>a. Open the embedded Web server (EWS).</li> <li>b. Select the Settings tab, and then select General Security from the menu on the left side of the screen.</li> <li>c. In the area for Direct Ports, select Disable Direct Ports.</li> <li>d. Click Apply. The device automatically turns off and then on.</li> </ul>
5 Disable printing from the embedded Web server (EWS)	<ul> <li>a. Open the embedded Web server (EWS).</li> <li>b. Select the Settings tab, and then select General Security from the menu on the left side of the screen.</li> <li>c. In the area for Set Options, clear the check box next to Display Print Page on Information Tab.</li> </ul>
6 Restrict users from sending e-mail to accounts other than their own	<ul> <li>a. Open the embedded Web server (EWS).</li> <li>b. Select the Digital Sending tab, and then select E-mail Setup from the menu on the left side of the screen.</li> <li>c. In the area for Default Message Settings, select Restrict users from editing all address fields. Configure the E-mail feature so that users must sign in to use it.</li> <li>d. Click Apply.</li> </ul>
7 Control access to the device	<ul> <li>a. Open the embedded Web server (EWS).</li> <li>b. Select the Settings tab.</li> <li>c. Select Device Sign In from the menu on the left side of the screen.</li> <li>d. On the Device Access tab, specify the level of control you want.</li> </ul>
