





Copy using the automatic document feeder (ADF)

| How do I? | Steps to perform |

| <p data-bbox="92 373 579 443">Load originals using the automatic document feeder (ADF)</p> <p data-bbox="92 600 705 737">CAUTION: To prevent damage to the product, do not use an original that contains correction tape, correction fluid, paper clips, or staples. Also, do not load photographs, small originals, or fragile originals into the ADF. Use the flatbed glass to scan these items.</p> | <ol data-bbox="730 347 1344 1091" style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="730 347 1344 459">1 Insert the top-end of the stack of originals into the automatic document feeder input tray, with the media stack face-up and the first page to be copied on top of the stack.<li data-bbox="730 600 1344 683">2 Slide the stack into the ADF until it does not move any farther. Document loaded appears on the control-panel display.<li data-bbox="730 785 1344 836">3 Adjust the media guides until they are snug against the media.<li data-bbox="730 1034 1344 1091">4 Press Start Copy on the product control panel to start copying.     |




Copy using the flatbed scanner

| How do I? | Steps to perform |

| Load originals in a flatbed scanner | <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="730 347 1339 403">1 Make sure that the automatic document feeder (ADF) contains no media. Lift the flatbed scanner cover.<li data-bbox="730 571 1339 659">2 Place the original document face-down on the flatbed scanner with the upper-left corner of the document at the corner indicated by the icon on the scanner.<li data-bbox="730 810 982 834">3 Gently close the lid.<li data-bbox="730 1026 1339 1082">4 Press Start Copy on the product control panel to start copying.  |
