

Printing a drawing with correct size and position

<u>Application:</u> Adobe Photoshop CS3 <u>Printer:</u> HP Designjet T1100 series <u>Software</u>: HP-GL/2 Driver <u>Operating System:</u> Windows



- 1. First recommendations:
 - Refer to the Media type functionality & features and choose the most appropriate media.
 - Ensure that the Paper Type setting on the front panel corresponds to the paper you intend to use. It is essential that the paper is correctly color calibrated for the printer; refer to <u>Calibrate</u> <u>my printer</u> document.
- 2. Open Adobe Photoshop CS3.
- 3. Configure the Color Settings, Edit menu > Color Settings...:
 - Make sure the setting **More Options** is displayed.
 - **Working Spaces > RGB**: Select the profile of the scanner or other device you have used to get the drawing (source profile), if you don't have it, select sRGB IEC61966-2.1.
 - Working Spaces > CMYK: Coated FOGRA27 (for Europe), U.S. Web Coated (SWOP) v2 (for US) and Japan Color 2001 Coated (for Japan).
 - Color Management Policies: Preserve Embedded Profiles.
 - Profile Mismatches: Check Ask When Opening and Ask When Pasting.
 - Missing Profiles: Check Ask When Opening.
 - Conversion Options > Intent: Perceptual.

4. Open the image, **File menu > Open...**:

If the document has an embedded color profile that does not match the current working space, select **Use the embedded profile**. Otherwise, select **Assign working space**; in this case, if the displayed image does not look correct, try assigning it to other color spaces with **Edit > Assign Profile** (try **sRGB**, **Adobe RGB**, **ColorMatch RGB** and others) until you are satisfied.

- 5. Adobe Photoshop **Print...** settings; **File menu > Print...**:
 - **Printer**: Select your printer device.
 - Set the **Position** and the **Scaled Print Size** you need.
 - Make sure the **More Options** are displayed.
 - Select the **Color Management** tab:
 - **Print**: Document.
 - **Options > Color Handling**: Printer Manages Colors.

- 6. Driver Settings; Click **Print One...**:
 - Paper/Quality tab:
 - **Paper Options > Document size**: Select the paper size of the media loaded on the printer. Select the **Custom...** button if you want to create a custom page size.
 - **Paper Options > Paper Source**: Select the source of the paper, Roll or Sheet.
 - Paper Options > Paper Type: Select the paper type that is loaded on the printer.
 - **Orientation**: Select the orientation of your image on the paper.
 - **Print Quality**: Select Standard options and drag the slider to Quality.

- Features tab:
 - Resizing Options: Select the scale option you want, select Print document on and the paper size on which the document will be scaled, or, the % of actual size. Make sure that the document size is not bigger than the paper size you have on the printer.
 - **Roll Options**: Check **Autorotate** checkbox.
 - Check Show preview before printing.
