# Setting up your tablet

If a micro SIM card is not preinstalled in the tablet. insert a micro SIM card (purchased separately) in the appropriate slot (see "Insert a micro SIM card or a micro SD card" section of this guide).



After charging the battery, press and hold the power button • the HP logo is displayed.

# Home screen icons

**Phone**—Allows you to make a phone call.

Contacts—Allows you to store frequently called phone numbers

- Search—Allows you to type one or more keywords to Google search with the installed search app.
- **Recent apps**—Opens a list of apps used recently.
- **Home**—Opens or returns to the Home screen.
- $\leftarrow$ **Back**—Opens the previous screen.
- **Voice search**—Allows you to touch  $\Psi$ , and then speak **U** one or more keywords to search with the installed search app.

**NOTE:** The icons on the Home screen and the appearance of the Home screen may vary.
