Installing hardware

If you purchased your product without a graphics card, you must first install a graphics card (purchased separately) before using this product. You can also install an optional hard drive (purchased separately).

Installing a graphics card

1 To remove the access panel:

- 1 Pull the service door release latch.
- 2 Rotate the access panel off the product.



2 To install a full-length graphics card:

- 1 Insert the card into the PCI slot.
- 2 Place the bracket on the card.
- 3 Tighten the captive screw on the bracket.
- 4 Install the non-captive screw into the bracket.
- 5 Install the non-captive screw into the card.
- 6 Plug the power cable into the card.



OR

To install a half-length graphics card:

- 1 Insert the card into the PCI slot.
- 2 Install the screw into the card.
- 3 Plug the power cable into the card.




3 To replace the access panel, rotate the panel onto the product until it locks into place.



Installing a hard drive


1 To remove the access panel:

- 1 Pull the service door release latch.
- 2 Rotate the access panel off the product.




2 To install the hard drive into the drive cage:

- 1 Lower the hard drive into the drive cage.
- 2 Install the four screws.



3 To install the hard drive into the product:

- 1 Lower the drive assembly into the drive bay in the product.
- 2 Slide the assembly toward the back of the product.
- 3 Tighten the captive screw.
- 4 Connect the cable to the rear of the drive.



4 To replace the access panel, rotate the panel onto the product until it locks into place.


