

Procedure

- 1. Move the printing bridge to the correct position for removing the aerosol cassette.
- 2. Open the print engine service doors on the operator side of the press.
- **3.** Disconnect the vacuum hose coming from the aerosol vacuum pump.






- 1 Vacuum hose
- 4. Disconnect the water tube.






5. Pull out the aerosol cassette.




- **6.** Go to the service side of the press and open the sliding doors.
- 7. Unscrew the suction cup by hand, and remove it from its base.



- **8.** Install the new suction cup, tightening it by hand until the suction cup is secure against its base.
- **9.** Close the service side doors.
- **10.** Reinstall the cassette by carefully inserting the rail into the bearings on the bridge. Keep inserting until you hear the click.

Caution:

The space for inserting the aerosol cassette is very narrow. Insert the cassette carefully to prevent possible damage to the capping assembly.

- **11.** Reconnect the water tube.
- **12.** Reconnect the vacuum tube.
- **13.** Close the print engine service doors.
